Electives and Research Minimum Effort Standard

Electives

- Appropriate Goals and Objectives for learning as defined by the Medical Education Committee
- o Minimum 40 hours per week
 - Clinical electives expected to have all 40 hours minimum in clinical activities on site
 - For non-clinical electives, Course Directors must define the on-site and off-site allocation of hours
- Assessment of skills and knowledge (e.g. observation of performance, exam, deliverable project, etc.)

Research

- 1. Minimum 40 hours/week expected
 - a. Actual hours spent should be flexible, given the unpredictable nature of research
- 2. Project is data and outcome driven
- 3. Tangible, deliverable product (e.g. summary, research manuscript)
- 4. Mentor's evaluation of the student performance on the project must be the person overseeing the student and their project
- 5. Presentation at either local forum for research elective projects, forum outside of BUSM, or BUSM Research Day is encouraged
