## Levels of Responsibility

## **Presenting Conditions**

**All**: Students are expected to take a patient history, conduct a physical exam, and provide both an assessment and treatment plan inclusive of anticipatory guidance and counseling where appropriate **Alternative Experience-** Students complete the requirement by participating in a simulation, standardized patient exercise, case-based session or online module.

## **Procedures**

Sim=Simulation or task trainer: Student performs a procedure or skill in simulation or by using a task trainer

**P=Procedure**: Students are expected to perform the procedure/skill on a patient **O= Observation**: Students are expected to observe a procedure done on a patient
