


## RPN Workshop Stats AY 2022-2023

  - BU/BMC: 21MUSC: 23UF: 28



# THIS IS RPN JEOPARDY!!

RESEARCH PROFESSIONALS NETWORK

## **GENERAL GAME PLAY**

- 1. Team leader will select a question from the Jeopardy board
- Team members will communicate with their teams & leaders via your team Google Jamboard
- 3. Team leaders will be called based on who raises their hand first
  - ▶ Be sure to answer in the correct format. "What is.... Who is...?"
  - Failure to answer in the jeopardy format will result in an incorrect answer and loss of points for your team.
- 4. If correct, the team will be awarded the points for the question and select the next question.
  - ▶ If incorrect, the team will lose the points associated with the question and the next team who raised their hand will be called on to answer the question....

Keep your hands raised until the question is complete

## DAILY DOUBLE & FINAL JEOPARDY

- 5. There are two Daily Double questions
  - Teams can choose to double the points for the question for each of the daily double questions
  - Doubling the points also doubles the risk, if you answer incorrectly, you will lose the twice the points
- 6. There is a Final Jeopardy Question
  - Teams will determine how much to wager on the Final Jeopardy question
  - The final wager will be direct messaged to Diana Lee-Chavarria in zoom chat
  - Once all teams have locked in their wager, we will display the Final Jeopardy guestides
  - Teams will have **30 seconds** to determine an answer
  - Each Team's final answer will be direct messaged to Diana Lee-Chavarria in zoom chat
  - We will call on each team lead to give their teams response and wager, calculate each team's final score, and declare the winner!
