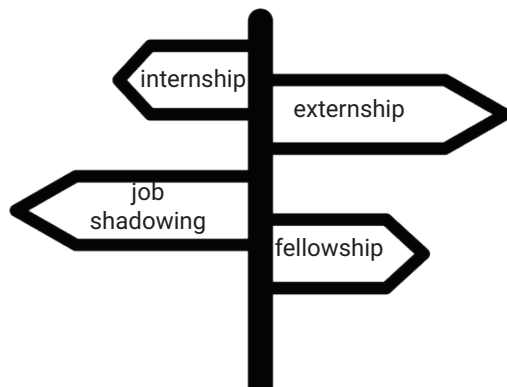

This seminar Lauren Celano, **CEO of Propel Careers** will provide details on ways to identify opportunities for internships, externships and fellowships to build valuable experiences outside of your Ph.D. or postdoctoral training.
