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Making our Front Line Patient Centered-- context

- Mortality reduction project- trying to reduce the unexpected mortalities. Focus is on patients on the general wards
- Many Departmental and Hospital wide initiatives to improve patient safety
- Recognition of clinical deterioration of patients on the wards remains a significant issue

Making our Front Line Patient Centered-- initial steps

- 1) All those who attend on inpatient wards will do a minimum of 4 weeks (total) on inpatient wards per year.
- Attendings will, at the minimum, hear about all new admissions on the same day of admission. Goal is to have patient seen within 16 hours.
- 3) Bedside PM rounds- Attending and Resident will see every inpatient each afternoon, briefly, to review vitals, test results, etc. Goal-Patient safety.
