# Search Timeline

## 4-6 months before

move-in: Decide what your housing budget will be, and where in Boston you want to live. Decide what furniture you need and start getting it.

## 2-3 months before

move-in: Put together a list of potential apartments from listing resources and contact all of them.

Evaluate the apartments on your list and decide which one is the best fit for vou. Put in an application for the apartment that you want.

Sign a lease for your new apartment.

3 weeks before move-in: Reserve a truck for moving day. Apply for a parking permit from the city.

1 week before move-in: Notify the post office about your address change.

Double-check your directions. Make sure you have a parking permit. Confirm truck reservations.

Call to have utilities turned on during your moving day, and turned off at your old apartment.

## After moving in:

Complete an apartment condition statement within 10 days. Contact city hall to get information on voting, trash days, recycling.
