Attorney General Maura Healey is the chief lawyer and law enforcement officer of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.






### Who the AGO Serves & How


# Golden Rule: If it sounds too good to be true, chances are it's a scam.

- 2. Always guard your personal information
- 3. Research well before agreeing to anything

Give you	Ask for	Offer "free"
money	money	prizes
<ul> <li>Fake checks</li> <li>Lottery "winner"</li> <li>Western Union</li> <li>Money Gram</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>"Victim" letters and calls</li> <li>Grandparent scams</li> <li>Green Dot</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Free trip</li> <li>Free trial</li> </ul>



Mail & Phone Scams beware of solicitations that...

Pose as the government or bank	Offer debt consolidation	Confirm personal info
<ul> <li>Robocalls</li> <li>Bank – "you owe a debt" or "account has closed"</li> <li>Sending fake gov't documents</li> <li>Arrest warrants</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Credit/Loan offers</li> <li>Debt Consolidation</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Deceptively sign you up for services</li> </ul>



Fake Checks definitions

### Could start with someone...

- Offering to buy something you advertised
- Pay you to do work at home
- Give you an "advance" on a foreign or domestic sweepstakes you've supposedly won



Fake Checks beware of...

 You don't have to wait long to use the money, but that doesn't mean the check is good.

• You are responsible for the checks you deposit.

 There is no legitimate reason for someone who is giving you money to ask you to wire money back.








Identity Theft Remedy overview...






