#### **Directions to Reebok International Headquarters**

#### From the North – Boston/Logan Airport

Take Route 93 (Southeast Expressway) South. In Braintree, Route 3 goes left and Route 93 South continues right toward Dedham. Stay on Route 93 until Route 138 (Exit 2B). Go to the lights and take a left at the Mobil station. Reebok is 1/5 of a mile on the left.

#### From the West – Mass Pike (Route 90)

Take Route 95/128 South to Route 93 North. Stay on Route 138 (Exit 2B). Go to the lights and take a left at the Mobil station. Reebok is 1/5 of a mile on the left.

#### From the South – Cape Cod

Take Route 24 North to Route 93 South. Stay on Route 93 until Route 138 (Exit 2B). Go to the lights and take a left at the Mobil station. Reebok is 1/5 of a mile on the left.
