MBTA Transit Pass:

- Eligible employees receive a 35%-50% subsidy for monthly MBTA passes through BU.
- Remaining amount is deducted pre-tax up to \$260/month; any amount above this is deducted post-tax.
- Enroll, cancel, and change pass types through BU Works by the 10th day of the preceding benefits month.

MBTA Pre-Tax Parking Benefit:

- Boston University Medical Campus employees who order a MBTA pass through BUMC are eligible to set aside pre-tax dollars from their paycheck to pay for their work-related parking costs at MBTA transit stations (up to \$260.00 per month).
- Enroll and manage the amount you wish to contribute through BU Works.
- The money elected to be withheld pre-tax will be credited to an account in your name to be used to pay for your work-related parking expenses at transit stations.

Bicycle Benefits:

- **Bike cage:** BU employees have access to a private bike cage behind the 710 Albany parking garage for \$20/ year.
 - Bike cage is sheltered, secured, and well lit. Maintenance stands and bike pumps are provided.
 - Must enroll for bike cage at TranSComm office.
- Employee bicycle commuter benefit: Cyclists who commute to and from work at BU greater than 50% of the time may be eligible for reimbursement for certain expenses. Eligible employees may claim a \$25 reimbursement each "qualified bicycle-commuting month" (up to \$300 per calendar year) for expenses incurred at any point during the calendar year.
- Borrowed bike locks: Cyclist who forget their lock, may come to the TranSComm office to borrow a lock during business hours.
- \$5 bicycle helmets: sold at the TranSComm office for adults and children.
- **Free safety/ bicycle lights** at TranSComm office.
- Free bicycle safety tune ups are scheduled by TransComm year round.

BU Shuttle: The BUS

- Free BU Shuttle access at stops along Charles
 River and Medical Campus Routes.
- Frequent service weekdays, Saturdays and late evenings.
- Real-time tracking on website (Live View), BU
 Mobile app, and Twitter.

Zipcar:

- BU employees receive a discount on Zipcar annual memberships at \$15/ year. This does not include Zipcar fees for the amount of time the car is rented out.

Blue Bikes:

- BU Employees receive a discount on Blue Bikes annual memberships at \$52.50/year instead of \$99/year.
- Email bumctranscomm@gmail.com for instructions and discount code.

Emergency Ride Home:

- Six free rides home a year (one time per month) up to \$50 value each ride if you commute by transit, walk, run, bike, or drive with colleagues.
- Use for personal/family emergency or unscheduled overtime.
- Must register and read rules and regulations in advance.

Motorcycles and Scooters:

- Motorcycles/ Scooters should NOT park at bicycle racks.
- Gas Scooters are not permitted to park in bike cages.
- Please read rules and regulations on website.

Bay State Commute:

- Get rewards for green commuting to work.
- Log miles in Bay State Commute portal. Miles will transfer into points that can be used to redeem free prizes.

Preferential Parking: 610 Albany Garage

- Employees who have the 610 Albany garage and drive an electric or hybrid vehicle or carpool can request access for the 1st level of the 610 garage at the TranSComm office.
- Carpool: Save time, money, and stress by commuting with BU colleagues. Carpooling is 2 or more people traveling in the same vehicle. Carpoolers must enter garage together.
 All carpoolers must enroll at the TranSComm office together to receive access.
- Hybrid vehicles: Hybrid vehicle drivers with access to the 610 Albany garage, may enroll at the TranSComm office to receive access to the first level of the garage.
- Electric vehicles: 4 dual charging stations in both the 610 Albany and 710 Albany garages. 8 charging spots available for active charging vehicles only - in both garages.
 Charging is free for the first 4 hours, \$10/hour after. Please move your vehicle when not actively charging.

Free Shuttles Services:

- Evening Shuttle: Silver Academy van. Boards at one central stop, located at 710 Albany St.
 Operates Monday through Friday (except holidays) at 5:15 p.m. 12:15 a.m. Travels to select MBTA stations and nearby South End neighborhood locations (within one mile).
- Inner Campus Shuttle: For patients only operates Monday to Friday (except holidays) from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. on a continuous loop from Doctor's Office Building. To contact the Inner Campus Shuttle, use BMC Internal Pager #6852.
- Boston VA Shuttle: Employees & students only (Pick up and drop off location: 85 East Concord St.) Operates between the VA Hospital in Jamaica Plain and Boston Medical Center. Times are subject to weather and traffic conditions.
- HealthNet Shuttle: Primarily for patients
