Paper, Thin Cardboard, Glass, Plastic, and Metal



Paper and Thin Cardboard

Glove and Kimwipes boxes Journals, catalogs, printouts

Metal

Cans

Non-lead foil

Glass & Plastic

Containers must be EMPTY and have held only benign contents (salts, buffers, growth media, etc.)

Intact glass or plastic #1–7 (e.g., tip boxes)

Pipettes, tubes, or tips Gloves, bench chucks Bags, plastic wrap

Towels, trash

Broken glass or plastic

ANY OBJECT that has contacted:

- Infectious/Biological Material
- Radioactive Material
- Hazardous Chemicals (toxic, corrosive, reactive, flammable)
