

Re: BUMG Faculty Testimonial for Shipley Center for Digital Learning & Innovation (DL&I)

As a clinician educator and principal investigator of Boston University Community Health Alliance of Medical Professionals (BU CHAMPs), I have worked with team members to develop an education and practice model embedded in the primary care clinical learning environment that teaches health professional students to work together on interprofessional teams. Understanding our collaborative practice and education model is new to many, we contacted BU Center for Digital Learning & Innovation for assistance in developing videos to both demonstrate and disseminate our model of care.

After an initial meeting sharing goals for the project with DL&I leadership, I virtually met Mr. Joshua Mackler who has since guided our team in moving forward our video development. Josh has been excellent at breaking down and explaining the process of video development and production to our BUSM and Charles River Campus faculty team as many of us have little to no experience in making videos. He has provided guidance in writing scripts for our planned three videos with 4-7 characters per video including helping our team clarify our intentions for each video, providing example scripts and recommending ways to get started. As a team of five faculty clinicians and educators, our schedules have challenged our time commitment to the project. Josh has been extremely flexible in meeting with the project team and in addressing everyone's questions, providing helpful resources and explanations. Additionally, with the time pressure of funding ending, he has helped us adapt our approach to the videos in order to accommodate budget and time constraints. I highly recommend the Shipley Center for Digital Learning & Innovation as their committed team members have provided valuable insight and direction to move our project efforts forward.
