RE: CALL FOR PROPOSALS: WCVI pilot grant announcement for postdocs

"The WCVI's mission is to advance the field of cardiovascular research and science. Investigators in the WCVI conduct and coordinate research and training related to the prevention and treatment of cardiovascular disease. The WCVI combines and integrates basic science, clinical investigation, and population science with the ultimate goal of advancing patient care"

## Eligibility: Eligible applicants

- 1. Postdoctoral Fellows/Associates and Cardiology Clinical Fellows with a formal mentor and a letter of support from their mentor(s) and
- All research to be conducted must be based at Boston University, Boston Medical Center.

**Budget:** supplies, and equipment related directly to the proposed research are allowable. The total request cannot exceed \$5,000 and cannot include salaries. Applicants may request up to \$5,000 in direct costs for a total of one year.

- The WCVI pilot award <u>does not include</u> indirect costs and cannot be used to cover shortfalls in other NIH awards or to augment projects that have been previously funded. As such no salary support can be requested
- It cannot be used for animal costs or animal-related costs
- The pilot grants are nonrenewable awards for a maximum of one year of support and cannot be extended

## **Project Title/ Contact Information**

<u>Project Proposal/ Description</u> (maximum 2 pages, single-spaced). The project description should identify the intellectual merit of your proposed work, and its broader relevance. The applicant must clarify how the pilot funding will support / sustain research efforts after the end of the one-year grant. Applicants should target their research proposal towards cardiovascular-related studies

References (1 page limit).

**Budget and Budget Justification** (1 page).

<u>Letter(s) of Support:</u> Please provide one letter of support from the research mentor (1 page). This letter should address their support for the project, the potential impact of the project, and the ability of the postdoctoral fellow to complete the proposed research.
