Keys – The Clerkship Coordinator will send an email with information.

Check- in – Students can check in Sunday afternoon or first day of their Clerkship

Checking out – To help ensure the apartment is cleaned and ready for incoming students, all students who have finished a rotation must leave the apartment by Friday evening.

Cleaning –The apartment will be cleaned between blocks. Routine cleaning is the responsibility of the tenants.

Trash and Recycling – Trash Day is Tuesday each week, and the Trash and recycle bins must be taken out that morning. You are responsible for taking the trash and recycling bins to the sidewalk on Tuesday morning and bringing them back in when you return from the clinic.

In the city of Providence recycling is required, no plastic bags in the recycling bin, no recycling inside of bags, and all recyclables must be loose. If a holiday falls on your Trash/recycling pick-up day, your trash/recycling will be picked up the next day

Parking – The unit has four parking spots in the rear of the building.

Supplies – The unit has all necessary dishes, utensils, and kitchenware. Students should bring their own twin sheet set, comforters/ duvet, pillow, and towels. Students will also need to purchase their own consumables.

Snow Removal – The Landlord will plow the parking spots and clear the walkways and stairs.
