Supporting our students

The Office of Student Affairs supports student group leaders by:

- Providing comprehensive new leader training to ensure smooth transitions and effective leadership.
- Managing the approval process for new student groups, facilitating their official recognition.
- Assisting student leaders with event planning, including:
 - Coordinating and placing necessary orders,
 - Securing room reservations,
 - Supporting budget management and oversight.
- Organizing key annual events such as the Career Expo, the Student Leader Wellness Summit, and ongoing student leader trainings.
- Maintaining and monitoring compliance with the students' Protection of Minors training to ensure safety and accountability.

Student groups organize activities and events such as speaker series, community service, and wellness activities. These activities contribute to our students in the following ways:



 A combination of 34 groups completed 2,742 hours of community service between February 2024 to January 2025

 Student organizations offer medical students numerous valuable opportunities throughout the year to promote healthy lifestyle habits in the community and volunteer services that respond to community-identified needs.



Career Exploration

• There are over **30** career interest groups to allow students to explore different specialties. These groups facilitate meaningful connections between students and faculty members, fostering mentorship, professional development, and informed career decision-making.

Enrichment

Student leaders, on average rating **4.6** out of 5, concurred that involvement in student activities significantly enriched their medical school experience.

Leardership

Participation in student groups provides medical students with valuable opportunities to develop leadership skills such as communication, teamwork, problem-solving, and decision-making.

Lessen burnout

68% of student leaders agreed participation in student groups decreased burnout
