Location and Meeting Times

- We will meet at the Boston University Wheelock College of Education & Human Development located at 2 Silber Way, Boston MA 02215.
- This building is currently under construction and the main entrance may be inaccessible on one or more of the days of SummerLab. If this is the case when you arrive, please follow the signs to walk to the right of the main entrance and enter the building from the rear. There is a gated door that you can use to gain access into the building. Please take the flight of stairs to the 1st floor and then use the elevator (or continue up the stairs) to come up to the 3rd floor. We will meet in room 309.

 Please plan to arrive between 8:30 and 8:45 am each day.
- Please note that the end time is an approximation. Each day may end slightly earlier or later depending on your group's progress.

Getting Here

- Find driving, parking, and public transportation directions <u>HERE</u>.
- Boston University Wheelock College of Education & Human Development is located at a 1-2 minute walk from the MBTA Green Line stop at Blandford Street, which may be more convenient than driving depending upon where you live and traffic conditions. Please note, however, that the MBTA B Green Line Branch will be out of service from July 17 - July 28. Buses will replace Green B Line service, but please expect delays and allow extra time due to the closure. Follow live MBTA updates HERE.
- Boston University operates a daily, free of charge shuttle that runs between the Medical and Charles River Campus. You can find the shuttle schedule <u>HERE</u>.
- Important Note for those who are flying to Boston's Logan Airport or coming from East Boston. The Sumner Tunnel, which connects East Boston and Logan International Airport to Downtown Boston and points north, will be closed 24/7 from July 5, 2023 August 31, 2023. Lunch

No open-toed shoes/Crocs/flip-flops/sandals are permitted in the lab. If the weather is hot, you can bring these clothes with you and change into them when you arrive.
- The temperature in the lab can vary, so we recommend that you bring a sweatshirt or sweater if you tend to feel cold in an air-conditioned setting.
