Overview

REDCap is a secure, HIPAA compliant, web-based application that supports data capture and management for research studies

REDCap was developed at Vanderbilt University and available to most institutions at no cost

REDCap is intended for data collection/management, not as a long-term storage solution



Why REDCap?

An EDC system designed for electronic data collection and real-time access

Secure & encrypted data on IS&T Virtual Restricted Use server behind firewalls

Reviewed and cleared as HIPAA compliant

Quickly design eCRFs

Streamline data collection and improve data quality with real-time data validation

Query & report on data at any time, from anywhere

User-rights management for controlling & removing user access

Audit logs of user activity and data changes



$Investigator \\ Responsibility$

REDCap security features do not exempt users from research compliance, responsibility, or Good Clinical Practice

Clearly define the project or research objective(s) and determine which data are required

Meet with a statistician/CTSI BERD to review the project and data collection instrument design

Confirm that your REDCap activity is in compliance with applicable regulations

Plan and review your data collection workflow

Project Phases

3 project phases in REDCap:

- 1. Development learn, build, test
 - Real data should NOT be entered until the project has been moved to the production phase.
- 2. Production collect, analyze, report
 - Draft Mode data form updates
- 3. Archived inactive, offline





Should you collect test data while your project is in development status?

- No, the project must be in production status to test branching logic functionality
- b. No, the project must be in production status in order to send myself survey links for testing
- Yes, I should test my entire project as if I were entering real production data
- d. Yes, I can enter test data while in development status, but should delete the test data before continuing with development programming



Data Collection Format



Classic

Instruments used at one time point



Longitudinal

Instruments are repeated across defined events/visits



Repeating Instruments

Ad hoc repetition (one-to-many) – no defined events; varies for each record



Unique links; custom invites; tracked responses



Survey Queue

Survey to-do list for participants



ASI

Scheduled invites based on defined conditions








How can I avoid deleting data from my project once it's in production?

- Take a survey offline to stop unnecessary data submission
- b. Use Form Render Skip Logic to hide an instrument
- c. Hide or retire fields and/or response options with action tags
- d. Manually stop future alerts with a 'kill switch' switch for ASI or Alerts & Notifications
- e. Do not grant the right to delete records

Best Practices

- Meet with a statistician to develop CRFs
- Use field validation whenever possible
- Do not change variable names or values of response options once you begin collecting real data
- Perform data export prior to making changes in Production
- Manage User Rights
- Enable DUO for 2FA login
