The M.S. in Medical Sciences (MAMS) Program introduces students to a broad range of topics in the medical sciences while strengthening their academic credentials for admission to medical and other professional schools.

The MAMS program is a 32-credit program, with a required thesis, that can be completed in one or two calendar years. All coursework is taken in the first year but many students elect to use the second year to gain valuable research and volunteer experience at Boston University School of Medicine (BUSM), Boston Medical Center, or off-campus.

All program courses are conducted at BUSM, and upon completion of the degree requirements, students are awarded a Master of Science in Medical Sciences by the School of Medicine.
