Summer 2021 registration begins on Thursday, February 25, 2021

Students Completing September 2021:

- Students completing their degree in one year must register for Summer 1 and Summer 2, and submit a diploma application for September 2021 graduation.
- Continuing students completing degree requirements during summer 2021, must register for Summer 2 and submit a diploma application for September 2021 graduation.
- Diploma applications for the **September 2021 graduation are due May19, 2021**. Please follow the <u>GMS Calendar</u> for all upcoming deadlines.

Undergraduate Courses (including BT courses):

• Students may not use federal financial aid towards courses that will not count towards their degree. Graduate students may not register for PDP classes, BT Courses, or undergraduate level courses or Audit courses). Unapproved graduate level courses at other BU schools and colleges will not count towards degree requirements, unless previously approved by program director and GMS Registrar.

Registration:

- Students must register online via the student link **after meeting with their advisor**. Not all students are required to register for the summer terms.
- Students in the Biomedical Forensics Science will be required to obtain an Academic Advising Access Code prior to registering. Contact your advisor.
- Research credits should be in increments of 2.
- Not all students are required to register for Summer 1. Check with your advisor or contact the GMS Registrar's Office (Ms. Millie Agosto millie@bu.edu; with registration questions.

Withdrawal Deadlines: (Absence from class or non-payment does not constitute an official withdrawal or dropped course. If your plans change and you are unable to attend a course for which you have registered, you must officially drop/withdraw from the class. Failure to do so within the add/drop deadlines for that course will result in your being held responsible for all tuition and fees associated with the course(s) in question.

- Summer 1, last day for 100% credit on tuition from May 24 to May 28, 2021
- Summer 2, last day for 100% credit on tuition from July 6 to July 12, 2021
