Have you applied for financial aid for Fall 2021?

If you will be enrolled in classes for the 2021-22 school year, please visit <u>GMS Applying for Aid page</u> for all relevant application information. The Fall 2021 or Spring 2022 GMS Aid Application Requirements section includes links to the 2021-22 FAFSA and the 2021-22 GMS Financial Aid Application.

Please note, in order to receive federal financial aid during a period of enrollment you must be enrolled in at least 6 credits. Some programs that include clinical work may carry enrollment of fewer than 6 credits. If you are completing full-time school work, but enrolled in less than 6 credits, please contact your academic department to complete their required forms.

Other SFS Reminders

Student Loan Exit Counseling for Graduating Students

Graduating Federal Direct Loan borrowers must complete the Federal Student Loan Exit Counseling. This can be done electronically at StudentAid.gov. If you have questions following your online Exit Counseling, you can schedule an individual appointment with SFS.

Summer Enrollment & Aid Application Process

Looking to borrow loans during the summer semesters? If you are enrolled in at least 6 credits across summer 1 and 2 or certified full-time and you wish to apply for federal loans, make sure you've submitted the 2021-22 FAFSA and the Summer Direct Loan application. If you need additional funds, you can submit the Summer Graduate PLUS Application. Otherwise, private credit-based student loans are also available.
