Greetings all GMS Master's students,

Summer 2022 registration begins on Thursday, February 17, 2022.

Our [GMS Student Website](#) contains all the pertinent information, links, and forms to successfully complete registration process.

**Students Completing Degree Requirements for August 2022 Graduation:**

- Students completing their degree in one year must register for Summer 1 and Summer 2 and submit a diploma application for August 2022 graduation.
- Continuing students completing degree requirements during Summer 2022 must register for Summer 2 and submit a diploma application for August 2022 graduation.
- Diploma applications for the **August 2022 graduation are due May 1, 2022**. Please follow the [GMS Graduation Calendar](#) for all upcoming deadlines.

**Undergraduate Courses (including BT courses):**

- Students may not use federal financial aid towards courses that will not count towards their degree. Graduate students may not register for PDP classes, GMS BT Courses, or undergraduate level courses. They also may not audit courses. Unapproved graduate level courses at other BU schools and colleges will not count towards degree requirements, unless previously approved by program director and GMS Registrar. (Only one non GMS graduate level course may be taken with program director/chair approval)

**Registration:**

- Students must register online via the student link **after meeting with their advisor**. Not all students are required to register for the summer terms. Check with your advisor or contact the GMS Registrar's Office ([GMSRegistrar@bu.edu](mailto:GMSRegistrar@bu.edu)) with registration questions.
- Students in the Biomedical Forensics Science will be required to obtain an Academic Advising Access Code prior to registering. Contact your advisor.
- Research credits should be in increments of 2.

**Withdrawal Deadlines:** Absence from class or non-payment does not constitute an official withdrawal or dropped course. If your plans change and you are unable to attend a course for which you have registered, you must officially drop/withdraw from the class. Failure to do so within the add/drop deadlines for that course will result in your being held responsible for all tuition and fees associated with the course(s) in question.

- Summer 1, last day for 100% credit on tuition - **Tuesday, May 31, 2022**
- Summer 2, last day for 100% credit on tuition - **Monday, July 11, 2022**
