## **Important Deadlines:**

\* Spring 2023 Registration Opens on October 23, 2022!

\* Tuition Payment Deadline is December 15, 2022 <u>Student Accounting Services</u> page.

## \* May 2023 tentative graduates must submit a Diploma Application PRIOR the January 2, 2023 deadline.

## Additional Information:

- MA and MS degree students are encouraged to familiarize themselves with their degree requirements and track their degree progress each semester. Degree requirements for each degree program are outlined in the <u>GMS Bulletin</u>
- Degree Advice is a web-based academic advising tool available for some degree programs. Degree Advice is customized per student degree and program requirements, transfer credit, waivers, and current registration information to update a student's progress seamlessly through his or her degree program. Students can access Degree Advice and a student guide via the Student Link: Academics >Academic Advising >Degree Advice.
- Prior to registering for any classes, all students must first meet with their Advisor/ Program Director to discuss course selections and to obtain the required "Academic Advising Access Code" for On-line Registration via the Student Link.
- Advising codes will not be release to any students who are missing official transcripts.
- MAMS students advising codes will be provided to advisors after October 31<sup>st</sup>,
- All GMS courses offered for **Spring 2023** semester can be accessed through the Student Link.
- For courses are restricted from on-line registrations, students must submit an Add/Drop via GMS Student Forms online submission (linked above).
- Students may ADD a course via student link up to the official add deadline.
- Students may **DROP** a course via student link up to the official drop deadline without a "W" grade.
- Students may **NOT** register or audit courses in other colleges at the University including GMS BT undergraduate courses.
- All students are required to register each semester until completion of all degree requirements.
- Students may only take up to two semesters of Leave of Absence.

- Certified Full-time Form: Students continuing in a program and not required to register for full-time course load due to the completion of other degree requirements, such as research, may submit CFT form prior to December 15<sup>th</sup>, via the <u>GMS</u>
  <u>Student Forms webpage</u>. Students should list supervisor, type of independent work and total hours per week during the specific semester or form will be denied.
- Visa regulations require that most **International students** register as full-time students either by course registration or by submitting a Certified Full-Time form if applicable.
- Students may not register or use federal financial aid towards courses that will not count towards their degree (*PDP classes, undergraduate BT courses or undergraduate courses or unapproved graduate level courses at other BU schools and colleges*).
- Any adjustments to course loads may increase or decrease the tuition due for the semester. Contact the GMS Registrar's Office <u>GMSRegistrar@bu.edu</u> regarding tuition adjustments.
- Masters students planning to graduate for the May 2023 graduation must submit a diploma application prior to the January 2, 2023 deadline.
- Student planning on complete degree requirements for the August 2023 graduation and who would like to be included on the sign-up email to attend May 2023 Commencement Ceremony must submit a diploma application prior to January 13, 2023.
- Students will not be allowed to submit Thesis or attend May 2023 GMS Commencement Ceremony, if a Diploma Application is not submitted by the deadline.
