Advising

• Meet with Advisor/Program Director:

- □ **Prior to registering for any classes,** all students must first meet with their Advisor/Program Director to discuss course selections.
- Program Advising Holds some students will not be able to self-register until the program advisor has approved the release of your advising hold and the hold has been removed.
- □ 1st year PiBS students must submit a program change form before registering for fall 2025 to formally request a change in their academic program.

Registration Requirements

- □ All students are required to register each term until completion of all degree requirements.
- GMS courses offered for the fall 2025 term can be accessed through the MYBU.
- Add a course via MyBU by the official deadlines Here
- Drop a course without a "W" and with a "W" grade deadlines Here

Restricted Courses

- For courses *restricted from online registration*, students must submit an online GMS Add/ Drop form via GMS Student Forms.
- PhD students may not audit courses at SPH.
- PhD students must maintain full-time enrollment status by enrollment of 12 units or more per term. Students must register for even number of research units.

- August 2025
 - Do not register for fall 2025 courses if you plan to graduate in August 2025.

- □ Students planning to graduate for the January 2026 graduation must submit a diploma application via GMS Student Forms prior to the September 16, 2025, deadline.
- □ May 2026 tentative graduates must submit a Diploma Application PRIOR to December 1, 2025.
