




# **Awards**

# Summer 2023 UROP Application Information

The Undergraduate Research Opportunities Program (UROP) will soon be accepting applications for Summer 2023! The application deadline is 12:00PM on Thursday, March 2, 2023.

A virtual information session with helpful tips on how to apply for summer UROP funding will be held on Monday, January 30 at 5:00pm.

**Summer Application Information** 

The types of funding for which students may apply include:

- Faculty Matching Grant (FMG): funding split equally between UROP and the faculty mentor's research funds.
- Student Research Award (SRA): funded entirely by UROP.
- Humanities Scholars Award: stipend for students conducting research in the Humanities
- Global Challenge Research Award: stipend and/or supplies for one summer and two consecutive academic semesters available to juniors conducting faculty-mentored research that addresses an issue of global importance. This year's topic is Public Health; applicants will be invited from the general applicant pool.
- Supplies Award: awards up to \$500 for research supplies, transferred directly to faculty mentor's department.
- Housing Support: No application necessary. Up to \$1000 toward summer housing (limited number of supplements available for students based on financial need as determined by Boston University Office of Financial Aid).
