

HemOnc Operations Updates





Please join us in giving Dr. Jackson a warm welcome to BMC and the Palliative Care Clinic!






BMC's HemOnc team is Making Strides!

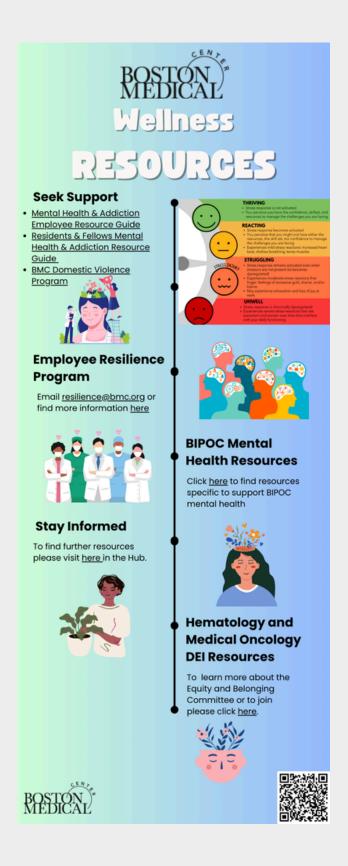
