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My clinical work is based at Harborview Medical Center which serves a similar patient population as BMC. I see patients in our After Care Clinic, which is a clinic for people who have been in the ER or hospital but don't have a PCP and often don't have health insurance. I have my own panel of primary care patients and supervise residents and medical students in the outpatient setting. I also attend on the medicine wards for several weeks every year. Lastly, I am on the eConsult team for UW Medicine and conduct quality improvement/assurance for the program.

I have worked in a variety of challenging clinical settings since graduating. I have worked as a hospitalist on the Navajo Nation, sometimes as the only internist at night (including covering ICU patients). I have worked in rural Liberia where I was at times the only doctor in the district or county. And now I provide clinical care and medical education at an extremely busy public hospital. My training at BMC prepared me to have both the breadth and depth of medical knowledge and skills to confidently care for patients and teach in this wide variety of settings.

Everyone at BMC—from my co-residents to faculty to staff and other hospital employees—believes in and works towards the mission of exceptional care, without exception. The residency program not only believes in and supports this mission but also provides residents with the training, tools, and mentorship to become leaders in their chosen fields. Training at BMC solidified my desire to work with underserved populations and to work towards health equity.
