The Midwifery Service in the Department of OB-GYN at Boston Medical Center is recruiting for a full-time certified nurse midwife

The Midwives at Boston Medical Center are looking to hire another member of our passionate, talented team for a full time, full scope position (36 clinical hrs/week). We are looking to cover labor and delivery and clinic, with an option to cover our busy, midwife-led triage unit. Spanish and/or Haitian Creole language skills are strongly desired. At least 1 year of midwifery experience and current Massachusetts midwifery license required. We are looking for someone with a passion for education, collaboration, and caring for a diverse group of women and families.

About our practice: BMC is a tertiary care center and New England's largest safety net hospital. We serve a diverse, multicultural population and have approximately 900 midwife-attended births/year. Our midwifery service provides full-scope midwifery care to women in 7 neighborhood health centers, the hospital OB/GYN clinic, and our Adolescent Center. We provide labor and delivery coverage 24 hrs/day, cover our post-partum service 7 days a week, and run our busy triage unit 5 days a week. We work in a collaborative model with highly supportive obstetricians, perinatologists, and family medicine physicians. Midwives are faculty appointed in the Boston University School of Medicine and are expected to teach residents, medical students, and midwifery students during all aspects of clinical care including clinic, labor and birth and triage. Research, lecturing and other academic activities are supported and encouraged. We are a multicultural group of 20 midwives who together speak English, Spanish, French, Thai, Cape Verdean Creole and Haitian Creole. We are committed to holistic care for women and families. We have a robust Centering Pregnancy Program, and have developed services such as our Birth Sisters Program, a multi-cultural doula service offering home visiting and labor support. We welcome another energetic midwife with a passion for birth, a commitment to serving diverse populations, an interest in teaching, and a team-oriented style. We offer a competitive salary and attractive benefits package.
