EXPECTANT MANAGEMENT CHECK LIST

- Do not place anything in the vagina
- I will take my temperature every 4 hours and return to Labor and Delivery if I have a temperature higher than 100.0 F
- I will check the color of my water (amniotic fluid), if it is anything but clear, has a yellow or greenish color, I will return to Labor and Delivery
- I will check my baby's movement: (Count the number of kicks you feel. You should feel your baby move at least 5 times in 1 hour. I will come back to labor and delivery if my baby moves less than 5 times in 1 hour.)
- If labor starts on its own or I notice vaginal bleeding, I will return to Labor and Delivery
