About The Essential1 Study

The Essential1 Study is evaluating an oral study medication to see if it may reduce symptoms of essential tremor. If you have symptoms of essential tremor, this study may be an option for you.

How Do I Qualify?

You may be eligible for the Essential1 Study if you:*

- Are 18 years or older
- Have had symptoms of essential tremor for at least 3 years
- Experience tremors in both hands
- Have not had surgery for your essential tremor

Patients currently taking medication for their essential tremor may be able to continue their usual treatment during the study.

*The study office can discuss with you any additional criteria to participate.

Why Take Part?

If you qualify and decide to participate, you will receive:

- The study drug and all study-related care at no cost
- Close monitoring by an experienced study doctor and staff who understand essential tremor
- The opportunity to advance medical knowledge and potentially help others with essential tremor

Your safety is the highest priority while participating. If you have questions or concerns at any point throughout the study, a study staff member is available. The study staff can also tell you about their specific COVID-19 safety protocols.

Your participation is voluntary, and you are free to withdraw at any time, for any reason. Your privacy will be maintained throughout the study.
